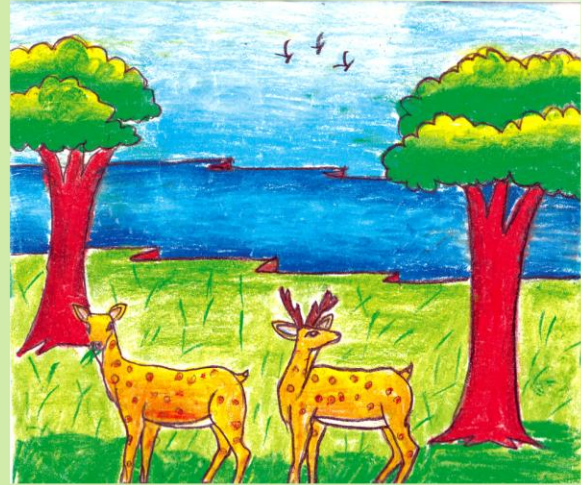

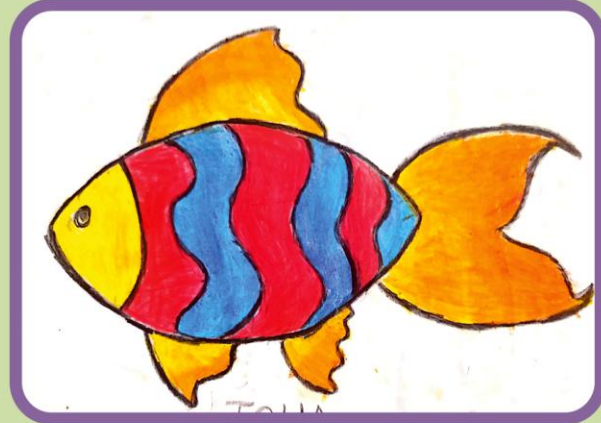
প্রিয় মুহূর্ত

নীল নন্দিনী দাশ (চতুর্থ - ক) - এনসি

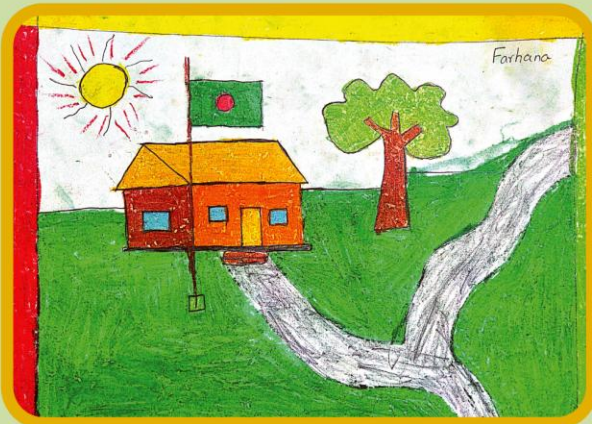

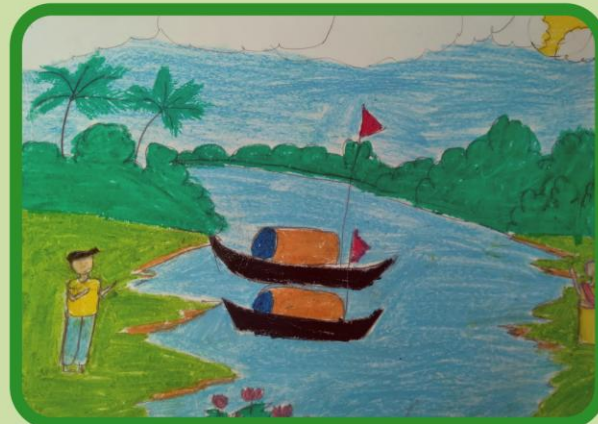

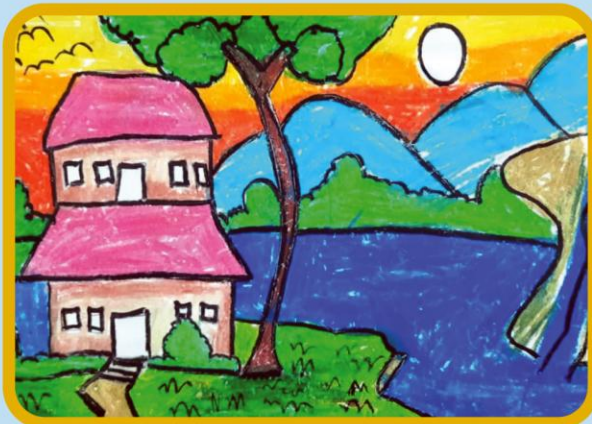
