## Book Review

# A Farewell To Arms

This book is written by Ernest Hemingway. Ernest Miller Hemingway was an American author and journalist. His economical and understanding style had a strong influence on twentieth century fiction, while his life of adventure and his public image influenced later generations. Hemingway produced most of his book between the 1920 -1950's and won the novel-prize in Literature in 1954.

THIS BOOK INTRODUCES BOTH Henry - the American ambulance driver serving in the Italian Army and Catherine Barkley. It also shows how they meet through Rinaldi, Henry's surgeon friend who knows Berkeley at the time. After Henry and Berkeley have seen each other for two times, Henry goes for a kiss in the rain at one point, but Berkeley refuses him and slaps him. He gets to kiss her later on, but shortly thereafter his ambulance suffers a mortar attack that kills his partner Passini and lands Henry in the hospital.

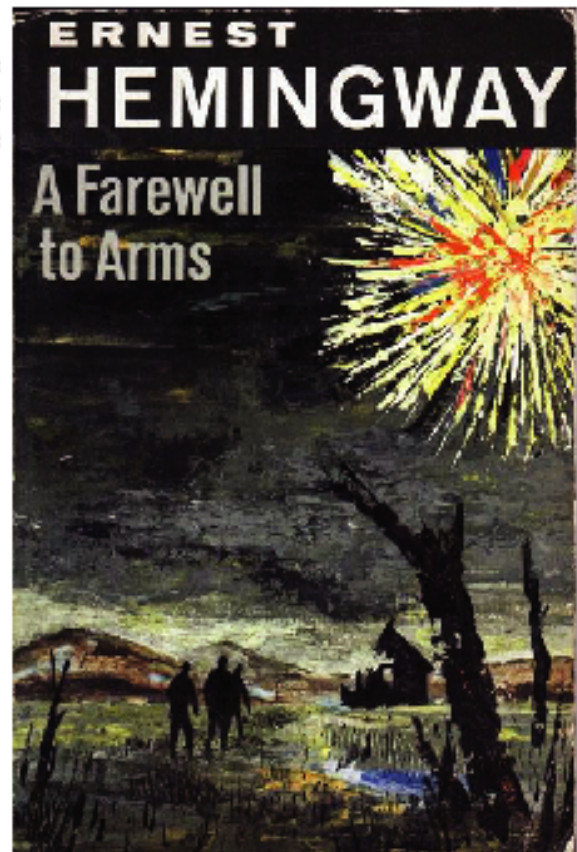
Henry is relocated to a hospital in Milan, and he requests to have Catherine Barkley assigned as his nurse. She arrives shortly after he does. They spend a lot of time together dating over the summer. After a long time relationship, they grow very fond of each other. Even though his injury heals, Henry knowingly pretends to be ill to stay in the hospital and to be close to Catherine.

He receives an extended leave from the Italian Army for his sickness (which was intentional), but one of the other nurses find out and reports him. He is ordered back to the war front and when he tells Catherine, she tells him that she is three month pregnant. He responds that they will wed when he returns.

Henry's love for Catherine fuels his hope for survival and guides his actions and decision making. It is Hemingway's way of relating the theme of hope during a time of war without speeches or evident imagery; instead it is found by analyzing the character's decision. Henry engages in friendly fire when his fellow soldiers decide to go AWOL because they themselves are afraid they will be overrun by Austrian troops. Henry is able to make it back to camp, where he is taken by military police because soldiers are being interrogated and executed for the "treason" that led to the Austrian attack.

Henry is able to escape and hops into a train on stowaway back to Milan. Catherine is no longer there; she has gone to Stresa. So Henry makes his way there and they are reunited. Henry is informed that he is wanted for being a war deserter. So Catherine and he flee to Switzerland. Their desire to fall in love leads them to a nice, quiet life up in the mountains for some time. However, Catherine endures a very difficult labor. Their baby is stillborn and Catherine dies for child birth complication. The novel ends with Henry walking off into the train.
