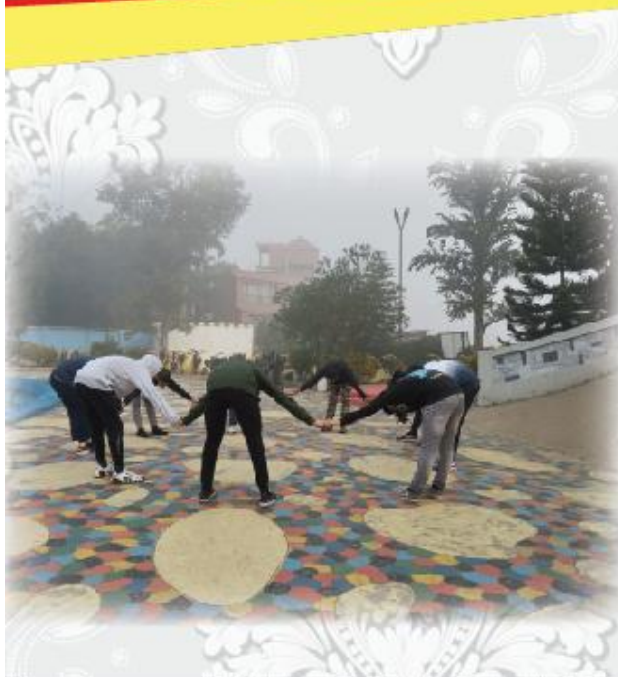

যদিও ধ্বনিতাত্ত্বিক নৈন্য কিংবা প্রায়োগিক কোন সমস্যাও এ ভাষায় নেই তারপরও বাংলা শেখার প্রতি অনিহা কিছু কারণ সঙ্গ করা যায়। বাংলা ভাষার পরিভাষাগত জটিলতা। মান সম্পূর্ণ অনুবাদ শব্দ তৈরি ও ব্যবহার অসম্ভব। সরকারি কাজকর্মে শুধু ভাষার ব্যবহার। উচ্চ শিক্ষায় মানসম্পূর্ণ বইয়ের অভাব। সাম্রাজ্যবাদী বিদেশী ভাষার আগ্রাসী ধাৰা। আকাশ সংস্কৃতি। বাংলা ব্যবহারে হীনমন্যতা ইত্যাদি।

বাংলা এখন পৃথিবীর অটুটি বড় ভাষার মধ্যে একটি। এই ভাষায় উচ্চ মানের সাহিত্য তৈরি হয়েছে। এই ভাষার কবি সাহিত্যে নোবেল পেয়েছেন। এই ভাষাই এখন মাতৃভাষা দিবসের মাধ্যমে সারা পৃথিবীর মানুষকে নিজ নিজ ভাষা রক্ষার ও উন্নয়নে অনুপ্রাণিত করেছে। এই মাতৃভাষা হিসেবে বাংলাভাষা নিয়ে আরও বেশি চর্চা করা উচিত। ভাষা একটি দেশের সাংস্কৃতিক ও ঐতিহ্যের ধারক ও বাহক। স্বদেশি সাহিত্য-সংস্কৃতির চর্চা এবং জ্ঞানভাণ্ডারকে সমৃদ্ধ করার জন্য বাংলা ভাষার বিকল্প নেই। বাংলা সাহিত্য হাজার বছরের ঐতিহ্যবাহী ও সমৃদ্ধ। রবীন্দ্রনাথের রচনা মুঝতে অনেক পৃথিবীজ আর ফরাসিরাও বাংলা শেখেন।
